Dear Council Member Cohen,

As per the request from your office, the Garden Oaks Civic Club mailed out a survey October 22 to all 1415 property owners (in all 5 Garden Oaks sections) regarding the \$18.5 million Shepherd Forest - Garden Oaks Storm Water Drainage Project being proposed for portions of Alba, Golf and Sue Barnett.

Property owners were asked to select a choice of streetscape widths for both Alba and Golf streets, one similar to existing Garden Oaks streets and one a city standard design. Property owners were asked to submit surveys with a postmark no later than November 10.

Out of a possible 1415 surveys, 400 were returned by deadline which is a response rate of 27.4%. Those owners adjoining Alba and Golf streets responded at a rate of 64%.

I would like to formally submit this letter of support for the neighborhood's official results of the survey as follows:

- Overall preference of the majority of property owners were for "no sidewalks" totaled 64% vs. 36% for some sidewalks.
- As for street preferences, 81% of the property owners preferred a 23' street width vs. 19% for a wider street (27'-41'). Of significant note, 90% of the property owners adjoining Alba and Golf streets preferred narrow, no sidewalk streets.
